Our Patients –

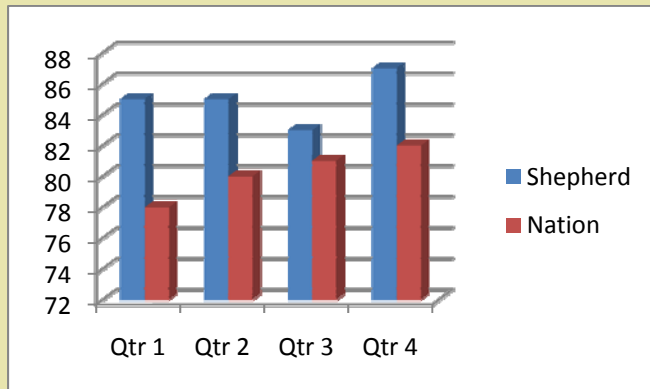
382 patients were admitted to the SCI inpatient program with an overall average length of stay of 56 days.

Nation: 47.5 years

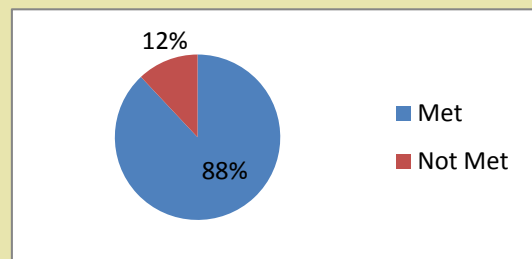
Overall Improvement—

Functional improvement is measured by the Functional Independence Measure (FIM). Functional areas that we measure consist of eating; bathing; grooming; toileting; upper and lower body dressing; walking and/or wheelchair mobility; stairs; transfers to and from the bed, wheelchair, tub/shower and toilet; bowel and bladder management; communication; expression; social interaction; problem solving and memory. We have exceeded the national average for all 4 quarters



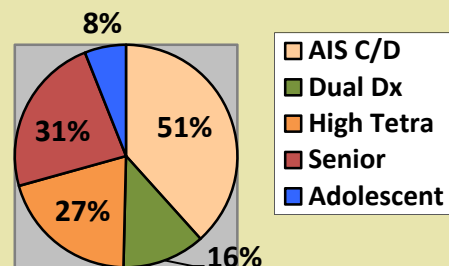
Goal Attainment-

Satisfaction-

All persons served will receive a satisfaction survey phone call shortly after discharge. The % of those who felt overall that they were satisfied with the inpatient experience (July, 2008-March, 2009):

SCI (2nd floor) 93%
SCI (3rd floor) 100%

Discharge Setting-

92.7% of the persons served reached their goal of going home. This far exceeds the national average of 73.9%
