



What is the SHARE Initiative?

It is a comprehensive rehabilitation program that focuses on assessment and treatment for service men and women who have sustained a mild to moderate traumatic brain injury and PTSD from the Afghanistan and Iraqi conflicts.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

- Have served in the OEF/OIF conflicts
- Have functional difficulties due to a diagnosis or suspected brain injury
- Have PTSD symptoms that do not require hospitalization
- Have a discharge plan
