There will be a half-day dedicated for continuity clinic one half-day a week (Friday AM) and a half-day for research will occur on Friday PM for outpatient rotations and inpatient rotations.

The outpatient clinic rotations will be split between SCI clinic, multi-specialty clinic, wound clinic, Urology clinic, Ortho hand clinic, Plastics/Wound clinic, and the SCI Day Program.

The outpatient clinic rotations at Children's – Scottish Rite will be for at least 2 weeks with the option of increasing to 4 weeks depending on fellow's request/interest.

Months are a proposed schedule. All rotations will occur but may move to accommodate the fellow's learning experience/interests.

PM&R consults and Neuroradiology rotations will be at Grady. Pediatric rotations will be at CHOA-Scottish Rite. ICU rotations will be with Pulmonary/Critical Care staff at Shepherd Center. Elective rotations may be taken at EUH dependent on fellow request/interest.

Vacation can be taken in any rotation block. Fellows will be allowed to take up to 15 days of vacation per year, with maximally 5 days per 1 month rotation, except during elective month, where any remaining vacation days can be taken.
