

During FY2020, 6,677 individual patients were seen in Shepherd Center's Medical Clinics.



#### **U.S. INPATIENT DISTRIBUTION**



1,189 employees (85%) raised \$214,714, and we received an additional \$30K challenge grant. These funds purchased new manual and power wheelchairs for


